Clinic Information

Welcome to Wild Deuce!

We are very excited to have you and your horse attend our clinic. Here is some general information regarding our clinics. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

- In our clinics we work with one student and their horse at a time. This provides you with one-on-one guidance and a hands-on experience that we feel horse owners need and deserve. This also allows you the opportunity to see us work individually with each student and horse – every horse is different and you will learn a lot by observing others.
- Our clinics are held at several locations, noted on our Clinic Schedule:
 - Our farm near Kingman, Alberta
 - At our Mountain Base Camp
 - Various locations for private clinics.
- For clinics held at our Mountain Base Camp, you must be able to walk-trot-canter comfortably on a horse. In our assessment, if we don't think your horse will be safe on the trail we will set you up with a Wild Deuce horse so you can participate in the trail portion of the course.
- You are responsible for:
 - Your personal provisions and food
 - Feed and care of your horse for the duration of the clinic. We supply water for your horse. Plan on having your horse on our highline.
 - Accommodation: we have camping locations for tents, trailers or campers. We do not have hook-ups for power, water or sewage.
 - Cooking facilities (note: at our Mountain Base Camp you have access to our kitchen fire for cooking)
 - We suggest proper footwear for riding, and a helmet.
- Come prepared for weather: snow, sun, rain, hot days, cold nights...all are typical in Alberta.
- For your horse we suggest you bring at least the following:
 - Proper fitting saddle with a rear cinch and breast collar.
 - Appropriate saddle pad(s)
 - Rope halter, bridle with snaffle bit.
 - Horse blanket
 - Vet kit, pails, grooming supplies, etc.
 - For Mountain Clinics: Saddle bags and a slicker. We also recommend you have 'heel/toe' shoes on your horse.
